WHO SHOULD SUBMIT WORK TO XJUR?

XJUR is for anyone interested in sharing their research with the Xavier community. Publishing in XJUR is a great way to build your professional portfolio. It's also an impressive resume / CV item: your publication could help you land an internship, job, or graduate school admission!

Students from any major can submit work to XJUR. Submissions may be work for a course, or work from faculty-supervised summer or independent research.



SUBMISSION PARAMETERS: RESEARCH PAPERS

Research papers should be submitted as Microsoft Word documents. Papers can be any length. Formatting for research papers should reflect the standard format used by scholars working in the discipline. XJUR also accepts digital (multimedia and/or web-based) research projects. SUBMISSION PARAMETERS: CREATIVE PIECES
